Kevin Wirth is the CEO of Leafcutter Press, and has been conducting research on viewpoint discrimination against students, educators, and scientists who are Darwin skeptics for over 25 years. He has just recently collaborated with Dr. Jerry Bergman and published a groundbreaking book on this topic, [*Slaughter of the Dissidents*](#). Kevin seeks to create greater public awareness of not only the plight of victims who have been discriminated against for dissent against Darwinism, but also provide access to vital information supporting a rationale for skepticism about evolution-related issues.

Kevin was born in Redwood City, CA and is a founding member and former Director of Research with *Students for Origins Research* (now *Access Research Network*, where he currently serves as Director of Product Development). Growing up with a deep interest in science, Kevin was educated in the California public school system where he learned and accepted the tenets of Darwinism without question. While a freshman in college, he realized that no one had ever challenged any aspect of Darwinism throughout his entire education, but his own critical inquiry soon uncovered many difficulties with evolution he had never been exposed to. As a result, he began documenting the issues he ran into, which eventually led to his association with many leaders in the creation and ID community, beginning in 1980.

Kevin has been instrumental in providing ID background research for many authors, including attorney Philip Johnson (*Darwin on Trial*), attorney Wendell Bird (*The Origin of Species Revisited*) and Dr. Jerry Bergman (*The Criterion, Slaughter of the Dissidents*). His areas of special interest include creating online information research tools on origins related issues and resources, and documenting discrimination case studies against Darwin skeptics. As a writer (see his blog at www.arn.org) and project management consultant, Kevin has over the years brought his skills together in support of several ongoing projects related to origins issues such as the Quote Verification Project (www.myevolutionquotes.com). His passion and focus is working with the public and within the ID and creation communities to help facilitate the networking of teams dedicated to increasing public awareness of these vital issues through speaking engagements, blogs, books, videos, and web sites.
